



A Leprechaun Story



This week, you will be writing a short story about a leprechaun. You can come up with your own idea or use one of the prompts below. Make sure your story has a beginning, middle and end. Double-check your work for correct spelling, capitalization and punctuation. Be as creative as you would like, but do not use any dialogue (where people talk to one another using quotation marks). Your story should be at least 2 pages of the shamrock paper (one side only, not back to back). That will be your final copy, so feel free to write your story in your writing journal first and copy it onto the final copy paper once you have made as many corrections as your can. I will not be helping you to edit your piece- so you will need to take the responsibility and do that yourself! When you have your story written nice and neatly on the shamrock paper, color the leprechaun head and body, glue a piece of construction paper to make the body and staple your story to the construction paper (see example on the board). This final draft will be due by _____ . Happy Writing!

Some ideas for your stories:

- ⇒ Amazing! You have just caught a Leprechaun. Unfortunately this leprechaun does not have a pot of gold. Lucky for you, though, he does have the ability to grant you three wishes. Write a story explaining your three wishes and why you chose them.
- ⇒ There are many things you can do with a pot of gold. What if a Leprechaun offered you a pot of gold? Write a story about a Leprechaun offering his/her pot of gold to you. What would you do with it?
- ⇒ Write about how you might catch a Leprechaun.
- ⇒ Write about the search for the Leprechaun's Hidden Treasure
- ⇒ Write about a Leprechaun's favorite meal.
